

Youth Sector Report
November 7, 2018

- 1- **Allocation:** Total number of allocations went up from September to October by 3.83. There is a 5th pre-k in region 3. In region 1, allocation is slightly down because of the mesure “partir du bon pied”; one school decided to use the money for technician time instead of teacher time. If we compare from October last year, allocation went up by 7.42.
- 2- **Pupil placements:** This is the first year in many years that the number of students has increase in elementary and in high school. Overall, this went up by 93 since last year. In the second part, comparison from September 2018 to October 2018 went down by 28 in secondary but total went up by 79 total.
- 3- **French qualification:** If teachers on contract want to get the French qualification, they need to do the CEFRANC or DALF C-1. Lester B. has an arrangement with McGill if they want to do it before June. Information is on SSO.
- 4- **Signing of contracts:** a memo will be sent to teachers on contract by the school board, to inform them of the new system that will be put in place for this year.
- 5- **Multi-grade classes at the elementary level:** Appendix XXV Special Measures concerning multigrade classes. The total amount is only known in late March; the school board has agreed to allocate \$250 immediately and will give the rest of it when exact amounts are known. I will send a memo to the teachers concerned when I get the official list from the school board.
