

Youth Sector Report

October 2019

- **Teachers' allocations** are posted on the following pages. From September 2019 to October 2019, teachers' allocations went down by 0.90 post. Allocations were added to: Beaconsfield High School (0.50) - for Cycle II Resource (to support the International Clientele); to Beurling Academy (0.25) - for Digital Campus; and to Lindsay Place High School (0.35) to reduce overage. Meanwhile, St-Thomas High School did not use 2 of their full-time teacher allocations. More allocations are coming shortly.
- The **parental workshop** will take place in the near future. Stay tuned for the date. Pasquale Machado at the PTU office is now in charge of the Maternity/Parental dossier. You can reach her at pasquale@pearsonteachersunion.com.
- **Contract teachers** in the Youth Sector should have received an electronic copy of their contract. It is the responsibility of the teachers to print and sign two copies of their contract – send one copy to Human Resource (Christopher Banville) and keep one copy for their personal file.
- **Pupil Placement:** Enrolment is up by 140 students in Elementary schools compared to last year and down by 38 students in High Schools. Region 1 has the most important increase in Elementary schools with an extra 40 students since September 2019, while in Region 2, High Schools suffered the most important loss with a 44 student decrease since September 2019.
- **French Qualification:** If teachers on contract wish to acquire the French qualification, they need to pass the CÉFRANC or DALF C1. The C1 test will take place on Friday, November 8th, 2019. More information is posted on SSO and AESOP.
- **Local Negotiations:** Will resume on October 23rd.
