Special Projects

The criteria for Special Projects has been amended to “majority of the teaching community” rather than “the whole teaching community” when applying for Special Projects at the school level.

Edgewater Elementary has applied for a Special Project for the math teachers at their school (K4 to Grade 6). This will cost approximately \$1,700, of which CPIC will fund 40%. This project was approved with the new criteria.

New Teachers

A New Teachers workshop took place on December 3. Sixteen (16) teachers attended. Modifications, Dealing with Difficult Parents and Work/Life Balance were all presented. Teachers also met in their pods. These workshops will now be paid for through measure money.

DPIC Budgets and Plans

DPIC budgets have not yet been released. DPIC Chairs are being encouraged to create and submit their plans even though they have not yet been given their budget.
