1. Staffing Timeline

The staffing timeline for the 2022-2023 school year will be posted on SSO, once the local agreement has been accepted by our members.

Important dates to remember until the official timeline is posted are:

By March 9: The draft seniority list will be in centres for verification.

By March 15: Request for leaves of absence. The form will be available on SSO as of February 1st, 2022.

2. Provincial Entente 2020-2023

Maggie Soldano and I met on January 17th to discuss the various modification in the new Provincial Entente that would affect the Continuing Education sector.

The items discussed were:

- Adult Education Workload Changes
- Vocational Training Oversized Class Compensation
- Vocational Training University Studies Credit
- Appendix XIV Mentoring
- Appendix XXII New Teachers Induction
- Appendix XLIV Funding for Support with Special Needs Students

3. Update on the Accelerated Health, Assistance and Nursing DVS Program and the New Administrative Support in Clinical Settings STC

The accelerated Health DVS was able to start as planned on January 17, 2022 and will run the 14 months to March 2023.

Due to the low English interest in the program, we seem to be the only English school board offering it. Both WICC and PACC have one cohort each. Of the students originally registered in the 22-month program at PACC, 80% applied and got accepted by the CIUSSS to participate in the accelerated program. At WICC, only 2 students showed interest and got into the accelerated program.

The centres were able to incorporate this program into their schedules without any major scheduling changes.

The Administrative Support in Clinical Settings STC of 240 hrs is slated to begin in March at both PACC and WICC.
