Virtual Campus and Online Instruction

EDDI Working Group

Grade 4 French Exam

The exam is not mandatory and is based on a DELF exam rather than a BIM exam. Teachers could still decide to administer an exam from BIM and could request an access from Marc-Albert Paquette, ESD Consultant, if needed. The information should have been shared at the school level. Questions will be asked to ESD regarding the DELF program and a presentation regarding the program will be offered at our next meeting in April.

Review of High School Exam Calendar

A calendar containing mistakes was shared with some high schools, but ESD has corrected the situation and sent in a modified and up-to-date version of the exam calendar. High schools Vice Principals attended a meeting regarding the end of the year exams on Monday.
